

# GISERA Communiqué

## National Management Committee Meeting #2 19 May 2016

The GISERA National Research Management Committee held its second meeting on 19 May 2016 at Santos' office in Sydney.

An update on NSW stakeholder engagement activities and their overall views and concerns was presented. A risk/gap analysis on these issues will be undertaken so that research proposals for tranche two can be developed. It was noted that five proposals will be put forward to the NSW Regional Research Advisory Committee as part of tranche one.

Overall, GISERA has committed \$15.6 M to ongoing research projects and the 25 research projects are an average of 76% completed.

The GISERA Director noted that there had been 27 engagements during the latest quarter, bringing the total engagement since GISERA's commencement to 602.

The National Research Management Committee granted the GISERA Director delegation to approve minor variations to projects in progress. This delegation is subject to clearly defined constraints.

It was noted that there had been strong interest in methane emissions in the Condamine River which has resulted in a number of media activities. CSIRO are working to generate a fact-sheet on the Condamine River which will include the science and our best knowledge on the information available.
