# 3. PROJECT PROPOSAL

# Community wellbeing and attitudes to conventional gas development in the North Perth Basin

The GISERA Director provided a summary of the project proposal.

Key points raised:

- As part of phases 2 and 3, it would be worthwhile obtaining views on potential geothermal related projects in the area, commercial natural hydrogen exploration and production and underground hydrogen storage.
- The minimum number of respondents to be achieved should be added to the proposal.
- There was concern raised that the response rate may be lower than required (especially from farmers). It was suggested that the research proponent:
  - utilise the Australian Association of Agricultural Consultants (AAAC) to identify and contact a number of agricultural consultants in the region to promote and encourage participation from local farmers;
  - contact the Growers Group Alliance (GGA) to disseminate survey information to their relevant groups; and
  - reports back to the RAC (a fortnight after reminder postcard is distributed) on survey response numbers and provide an indication of whether response rate is adequate, and if not, what modification will be made to ensure sufficient responses are achieved.
- The RAC would like to see what the postcard will look like as content/presentation might determine whether farmers respond or discard survey request.

<u>Outcome</u>: The WA RAC would like the research proponent to revise the proposal taking to account all the points raised and submit a revised proposal to the RAC for consideration out of session.

<u>Action</u>: The research proponent to obtain views on potential geothermal projects, natural hydrogen exploration and production and underground hydrogen storage as part of phases 2 and 3.

Action: The research proponent to include number of minimum respondents to be achieved.

<u>Action</u>: The research proponent to contact AAAC and GGA to help promote farmer participation in survey.

Action: The research proponent to provide example of mock postcard to RAC.

<u>Action</u>: The research proponent to provide update to RAC on survey response two weeks after postcard reminder is distributed.
